Maryland Nonprofits President and CEO, Darryl A. Jones, Sr., Resigns for Health Reasons

BALTIMORE, Md., Feb. 15, 2012 - Maryland Nonprofits announced today that President and CEO Darryl A. Jones, Sr. has tendered his resignation for health reasons. "As much as I love this position and this organization, good leadership requires us to know when it's time to move on," he said of his decision.

Board Chair, Janice Frey-Angel, expressed the board's gratitude to Mr. Jones for his extraordinary leadership over the past three and a half years; "Darryl has led the organization through challenging times and positioned us well for the future. We wish him all the best."

The Board of Maryland Nonprofits has appointed Sally J. Patterson as Interim President and CEO during the transition and executive search process. She previously served in this capacity during Mr. Jones' medical leave.
